#### Dear Rodeo Contestant

We have received your pre-registration for the 35<sup>th</sup> Annual Arizona Gay Rodeo that will be February 14-16, 2020 at Corona Ranch and Rodeo Grounds – 7611 S 29<sup>th</sup> Ave – Laveen (Phoenix), Arizona. The venue is on the southeast corner of South 29<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Baseline Road. This rodeo is an IGRA-sanctioned rodeo, and all 2020 IGRA Rules apply.

The Barn Manager is Patrick Terry, and his phone number is (719) 510-6116. The number of stalls you requested on your entry form have been reserved in your name. **Stalls are uncovered, and choice of stall(s) is on first-come, first served-basis.** Contestants receive one stall at no charge, and each additional stall is \$25.00 for the weekend. You may check in beginning at noon Thursday – February 13. All horses, trailers, and equipment must be off the rodeo grounds by noon Monday – February 17. Tack stalls are not available.

Shavings can be purchased from the Barn Manager for \$5.00 a wheelbarrow.

Parking is available in the parking lot for trailers with living quarters for \$20.00 for the weekend (Thursday-Monday). Upon your arrival, the Barn Manager will direct you to the appropriate parking area. Generators/electricity and water hookups are not available. All vehicles must enter the parking lot through the gate on 29<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

Non-contestants staying with a contestant in their trailer must purchase a buddy pass for \$25.00 for the weekend, or buy a regular admission ticket for \$15.00 per day. Buddy passes will be available for purchase during contestant registration Friday night. The "buddy" must be present to sign the liability waiver when the pass is purchased. Buddy passes can be purchased only after you have received your rodeo number. Individuals with a buddy pass must conform to the same dress rules and other rules as contestants.

Outside food/beverages are permitted in your trailers and immediate area, but they cannot be taken into the arena, seating areas, pavilion, or any other part of the rodeo venue.

Pets are permitted in your trailer. If outside the trailer and in the immediate area, they must be on a leash, under the owner's control, and remain in the immediate area of the trailer.

Contestant registration will be from 6:00 to 8:00 pm Friday – February 14 on the back patio at Corona Ranch and Rodeo Grounds. The Rodeo Secretary is Guy (Porkchop) Puglisi, and his phone number is (702) 339-3286. If you will be late or unable to arrive for registration before 8:00 pm, you must call Guy and let him know. Also, you need to let him know if someone else will pick up your registration materials. Only cash and credit cards will be accepted; no checks will be accepted. Credit card options are VISA, MasterCard, American Express, and Discover.

The rodeo will begin at 10:00 am each day, and the gates will open at 8:00 am for officials and staff and at 9:00 am for others. The Sunday evening awards ceremony is scheduled for 8:00 pm Sunday – February 16 in the dance hall/pavilion at the rodeo venue. A buffet dinner is also planned for a nominal charge of \$22.00 per person.

Camp events will have a one (1) minute time limit.

#### **Variance**

A variance for arena size of 131 feet wide X 130 feet 6 inches long was included on the rodeo application that was approved by the IGRA Board of Directors in their July 6, 2019 meeting. The alleyway going into the arena is covered and well lit.

## <u>Veterinarian</u>

Dr Gayle Leith is the on-site veterinarian, and she will be on the rodeo grounds by 9:30 am Saturday and Sunday. Attached is a document that lists numbers to call for emergency services during non-rodeo hours.

#### Security

Overnight security will be provided; however, the pavilion doors will be locked each evening at the conclusion of activities.
