EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The IGRA wishes to migrate off the system it's currently using to one which more seamlessly and effectively services the needs of rodeo participants, staff and IGRA officials. The new solution will take a fresh approach to implementation focusing on the specific user-interface, logic flow behaviors and data fields required by the IGRA. Past source-code resources from an older system pre-dating the current one have been made available for reference and review to aid in this process. The new system will incorporate both desktop and mobile versions. The requirements of behaviors, screens and outlines in this document are expected to change based on feedback from IGRA stakeholders until a final draft is complete.

Pre-Rodeo

- » Create rodeo, specify running order of events
- » Online registration opens 4 weeks prior; closes 2 weeks prior,
 - Account creation
 - Account management
 - Payment processing
 - Printing of competition number on competitor's own printer
- » Onsite registration as contestants show up in person (tablet/laptop)
- » Pre-registrants arrive and pay balance (if applicable), receive paperwork in single transaction from clerk/cashier via tablet/mobile printer
- » All pre-event online registrations and day-of onsite registrations will be consolidated real-time by design (into the same DB)
- » Click on no-shows to exclude them, confirm final official list of contestants
- » Click function submit button to finalize list of contestants
- » Rodeo Audit Report now available
- » Generate Event Control Sheets, running orders in the system, print out copies on paper to be posted next to the arena

During Rodeo

- » Tablet-accessed digital scoring forms for judges and for the scorekeeper (which are ECS's plus columns for times/scores/penalties);
 - Scorekeeper's scoring form
 - Judge's scoring form for timed events
 - Judge's scoring form for rough stock events
- » **Auditor & secretaries will have not have to manually enter, cross-check or audit ANY event scoring data at all. The system will be capturing, persisting and tallying all data real-time, rendering the vast majority of office work done currently to be unnecessary. This is one of the primary advantages of a new system.**
- » All aspects of the system will be consolidated into a single web application and database, which will also render well on mobile devices including smartphones and tablets. RWE will work with IGRA staff to ensure good-looking output of all interfaces, reports and print-outs, eliminating any need to utilize 3rd party apps such as Microsoft Word in a supplementary fashion.
- » Event Draws will be generated randomly by the system, and contestant ordering will be automatically reversed between the 2nd go-round and the 1st go-round.

During Rodeo (*continued*)

- » Ensure scorekeeper/judges have a confirmation page for each event to visually confirm their entries to reduce human error
- » Auditor and/or Secretary will click online “Process Event” function submit button and “Run Event” function submit button (these may be combined as there may be no functional reason to distinguish them in the new system);
- » The system will auto-generate all results/payouts based on scorekeeper/judging data that was captured and processed. All results will be calculated by the system (Contestant, Placement, Time, Points, Payoff, World). *(To reiterate: no manual entry of any scoring/judging/disqualification or other real-time competition data; no dual entry of data or cross-checking; elimination of most incremental data entry/tabulation steps as system captures everything electronically and tabulates results when event is over.)*
- » Click “Finalize Event” to prevent any further editing/modifications
- » Payouts, All-Around Results, Prize Money, World Champion Awards and Check Management functions will all be designed and implemented in the system according to “Rule XIV - Rodeo Awards” on pages 88-94 of the “2020 Rodeo Rules” manual.
- » In addition to digital copy made available online at end of event, results will be printed out and posted (including multiple copies e.g., “NCR’s”) - official copies theoretically go to association (archives/crate - but with new system may just be accessed online), announcer (may digital copy), auditor, and post online for contestants to see
- » Ribbon labels for the day printed, to be adhered to physical ribbon awards

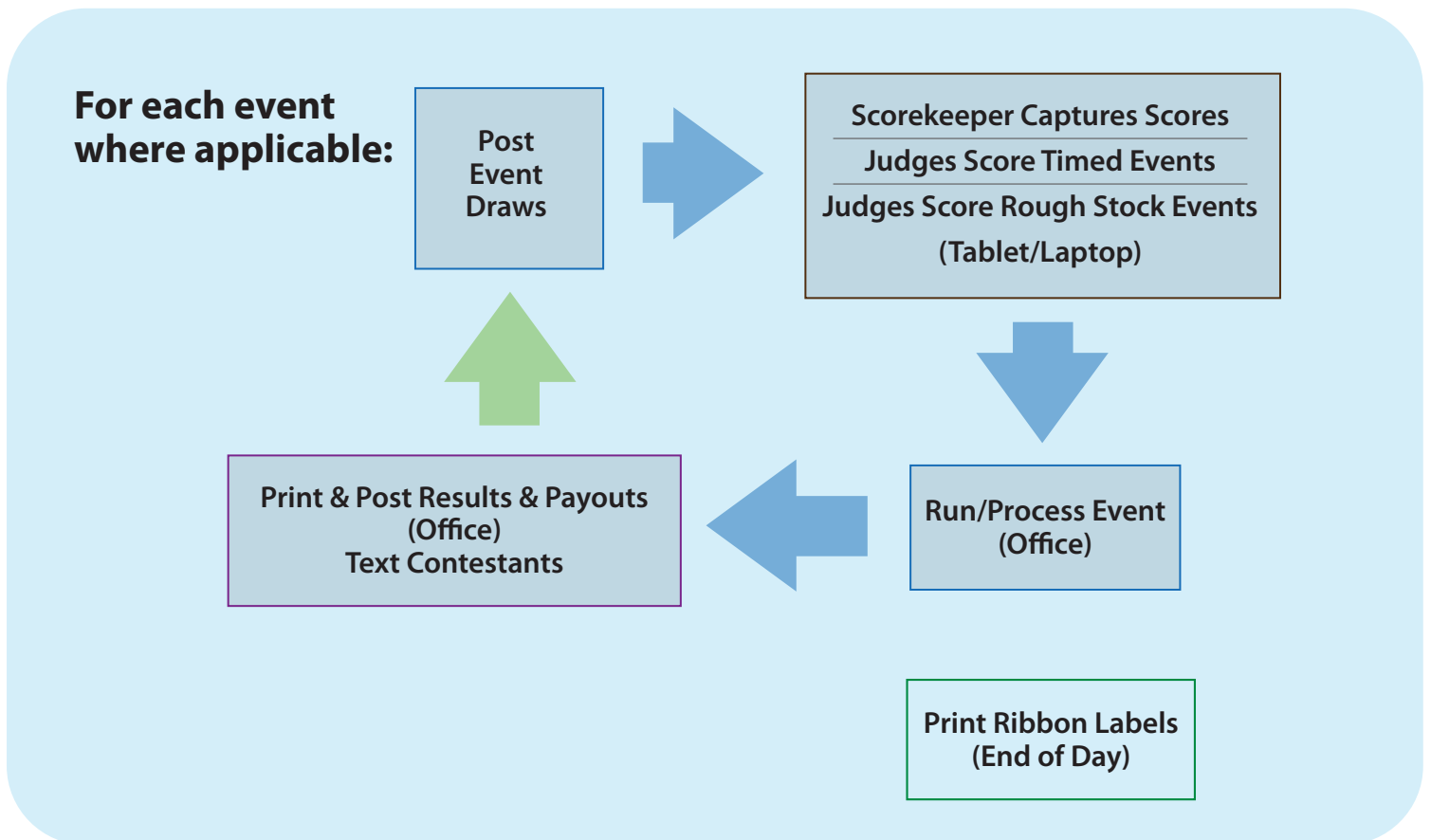

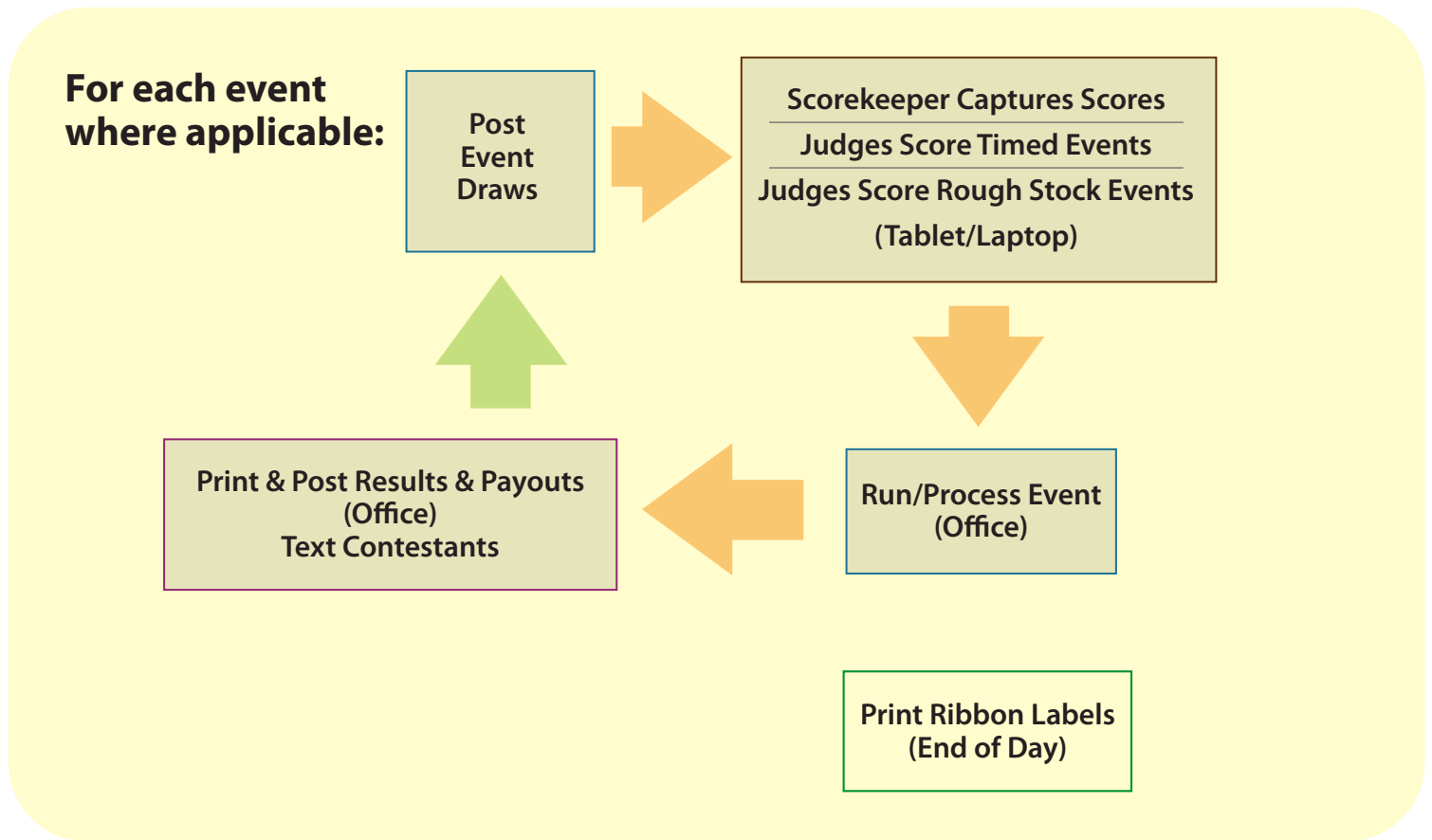
Registration Day



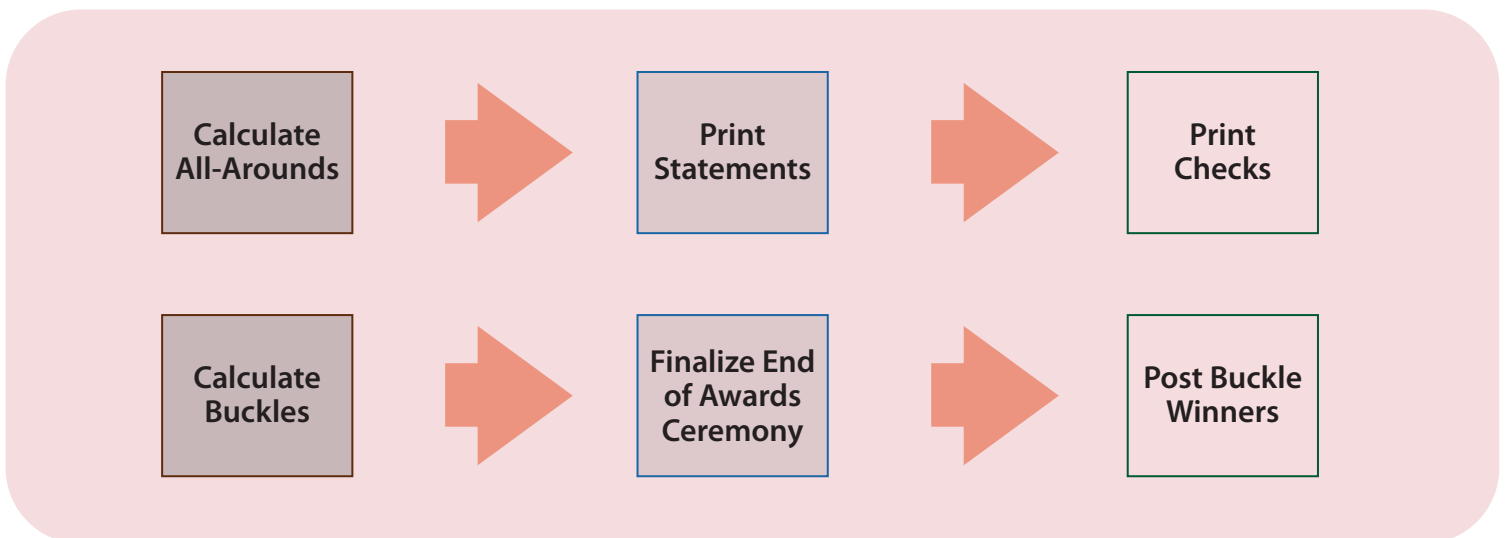
1st Go-Round
